When API Delta Chapter considers a deserving candidate of the Meritorious Service Award, we seek to find an individual who has distinguished himself both in professional life and in the community through involvement and charitable giving. This year's recipient of the Meritorious Service Award, Rick Fowler, excels in both these areas and has steadfastly established himself as an innovator both in his career and in contributions to local charitable organizations and professional societies.

Rick Fowler has been the Vice President of Deepwater Projects for LLOG Exploration since 2007. Prior to joining LLOG, Rick was employed by Dominion E&P (formerly CNG Producing) where he was in charge of exploration, development, and production in Dominion's Offshore Business Unit which included the management of over 300 employees. In these capacities, Rick has been involved in seven Gulf of Mexico (GOM) projects using new floating production systems (FPS) and numerous subsea tieback projects. Many of these projects have been unique both from engineering and financial perspectives. Along with Rick's technical and managerial accomplishments, he has a long list of distinguished service within professional societies and among the GNO community. Rick often gives lectures at Tulane's Energy Institute and was awarded for raising the most money for his participation in "Men Who Cook" benefitting Hope House in 2015. Rick has presented to over 20 industry groups, written four technical papers presented at OTC, and recently won the best presentation award at Topsides 2017. Rick's profoundly meaningful years of service are a testament to his character and deserving of recognition.
