**James R. Moffett** is Chairman of the Board of Directors of Freeport-McMoRan Inc. (NYSE: FCX). FCX is a premier U.S.-based natural resource company with an industry-leading global portfolio of mineral assets, significant oil and gas resources and a growing production profile. Under Mr. Moffett's leadership, in 1988 FCX discovered the Grasberg ore complex in Papua, Indonesia, which contains one of the world's largest reserves of copper and gold. In 2007, FCX acquired the Phelps Dodge Corporation in a \$26 billion transaction that created the world's largest publicly traded copper company. In 2013, FCX completed the \$19 billion acquisition of Plains Exploration & Production Company (PXP) and McMoRan Exploration Co. (MMR), adding high-quality oil and gas assets to FCX's global mining business.
