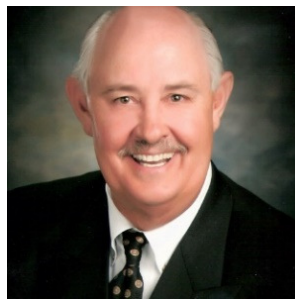

Honoring: Joe Bernard

API-Delta Chapter honors outstanding individuals with the Meritorious Service Award, recognizing those who have excelled both professionally and through their community involvement and charitable contributions.



Joe Bernard has been employed with Pro-T for nearly 30 years, a milestone made possible by Ricky Parvino believing in him. Over the years, Joe has leveraged his expertise to contribute to numerous industry organizations and events.

For 16 years, Joe served as Co-Chairman of the Registration Committee for LAGCOE. He also founded The Lunch Bunch 35 years ago, bringing together several service companies to cook for AADE Golf Tournaments across the New Orleans, Lafayette, and Houston Chapters, as well as the Society of Petroleum Engineers Houston Chapter Sporting Clay Tournament, where he and his team have provided meals for 650 participants.

His dedication to AADE extends to the Fin Feather Fur Food Festival, where he has been an active since its inception, continuing his involvement for 25 years with the AADE New Orleans Chapter. Joe played a key role in establishing an AADE Fin Feather or Fur Food Festival in the Lafayette Chapter, helping raise thousands of dollars for scholarships over a 5-year span. He was also Chairman for the Lafayette Chapter's Golf Tournament for 5 years and co-chaired the AADE Fin Feather Fur Food Festival National (AADE F5) for 20 years.

Beyond AADE, Joe has been involved in the API-Delta Sporting Clays Tournament alongside Barney Paternostro and Jake Carpenter. He also participated in the Southeast Texas Oilman's Fishing Tournament at Toledo Bend, raising funds for The Boys and Girls Club of East Texas. For the past 4 years, he has co-chaired the Steve Gleason F5 Foundation in Lafayette, continuing his commitment to charitable efforts.

Through all of his contributions, Joe has been supported by his wife, Laura, whose encouragement has been invaluable throughout their 45 years together. Her unwavering support has played a crucial role in his dedication to these great organizations.
